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### WHAT IS COMPOST?

**Compost** is a mix of fruit and vegetable waste that is added to the soil to help plants grow.





We love fruits! We do not put peels in the trash.  
Let us show you what we do with them.



First, we save our fruit and vegetable waste.  
We put them into our compost container.



Next, when the container is full, we dump it on our compost pile.  
Our compost pile is at the bottom of our banana tree.



Finally, we add a layer of cardboard to cover the vegetable waste.  
The cardboard helps to turn the waste into fertilizer.



Our avocado tree has a compost pile too! The compost helps to keep the tree healthy. It will make delicious fruit!
