



# COVID-19 HEALTH

<b>LEARNING MODEL</b>	<b>Full in-person learning models</b> for all campuses and preschools. Note: full-distance models <u>not</u> widely available.		
<b>KS APPROACH</b>	(1) Prioritize health and safety (2) encourage COVID-19 vaccinations, as the leading public health strategy and best way to stay and keep others safe. However, we also respect personal health situations and will provide a weekly testing alternative for those who are not registering with us as vaccinated. (3) We trust that each of us will continue to embrace the kuleana of caring for ourselves, our loved ones, and those in our school community. (4) adjust to new and credible data and research.		
<b>CONDITIONS</b>	KS will monitor internal and external conditions for community transmission; vaccination rates; frequency of unvaccinated testing; trends in local outbreaks; and children’s ages. Then, consistent with federal, state and county laws, KS will set and adjust (e.g., add/maintain/remove) these layered preventions: (1) promoting vaccinations; (2) wearing masks; (3) physical distancing; (4) testing/screening; (5) ventilation; (6) handwashing; (7) staying home when sick; (8) contact tracing; and (9) cleaning. Preventions below are based on current conditions and subject to change.

<b>PROGRAMS &amp; ACTIVITIES</b>	Certain voluntary Grades 7-12 programs and activities, including athletics, performing arts, and Staff/Student travel may only be available to Staff and Students who are registered as vaccinated. Check with your campus leaders.		
<b>ATHLETICS</b>	Students, coaches and staff participating in athletics are required to be vaccinated, unless exempt for a Medical or Religious Exemption or Accommodation. Students, coaches or staff who are granted an exemption or accommodation from vaccination will be subject to weekly COVID Testing, with the possibility of additional testing to meet the requirements of their school’s respective athletic league and/or competitor league.		
<b>HEALTH</b>	Elevated cleaning, hand-washing, hygiene, and ventilation required.		
<b>CLASSROOMS &amp; FACILITIES</b>	Regular classroom occupancy with 3-6 feet distancing, where feasible. Cohorts will be followed, where feasible - for preschools DHS requires “cohorts.” Masks not required when actively eating or drinking.		
<b>BUSES</b>	N/A	75% – 100% capacity; no more than two per seat; increase bus transports as needed to provide full service; masks required at all times.	75% – 100% capacity; no more than two per seat; increase bus transports as needed to provide full service; masks required at all times.
<b>GATHERINGS</b>	In-person meetings or gatherings of more than 25 individuals must be approved by campus leaders. Visitors/ volunteers permitted onsite subject to KS visitor safety rules (e.g., mask, wellness check-in, distancing), which may require screening testing if not fully vaccinated.		
<b>RETURN AFTER ILLNESS</b>	For Staff and Students: Stay home if feeling sick. For Staff: Required to follow current return to work practices. For Students: For absences of 4 or more days, a doctor’s note required; for absences of 3 or fewer days, a doctor’s note or negative PCR test required – in order to return.		
<b>RESPONSE PLAN</b>	For Staff and Students (registered or unregistered): Subject to KS’ response plan for testing, contact tracing and quarantining, in conformance with federal, state and county guidance. <b>TRAVEL</b>	For Staff and Students (registered or unregistered): Subject to federal, state and county guidelines for pre-travel testing, vaccination and quarantining. Certain school travel may also be subject to vaccination requirements.
