Information for Current Students

If you need a copy of your high school transcript for summer programs, college applications or scholarships, please submit transcript request in **Naviance**. The transcript request is located in the 'Colleges I'm applying to' tab. Transcript requests will be processed within seven (7) business days. Requests should be submitted well in advance of your deadlines.

Please go to: <https://student.naviance.com/maui> to submit your transcript request in Naviance. Start by clicking on 'Alumni'. You must type in your Kamehameha Schools email address: **first.last** @imua.ksbe.edu and then your last known password at the time of graduation. If you do not remember your password, you will need to reset your password.
