







## Lower Division Haumāna Guidelines for Distance Learning and Online Expectations

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| <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Academic<br/>Kuleana</b></p>                                        | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Students should <b>participate</b> in their online learning as delivered in Canvas/Seesaw as they would during their regular face-to-face schedule.</li> <li>Participation in live Zoom (synchronous) sessions are required unless otherwise arranged with kumu.</li> <li>Students should demonstrate high levels of <b>engagement</b>. As a contributing member of their online learning community, this includes: sharing content and ideas, asking questions, participating in dialogue and discussion and supporting peers when able.</li> <li>Students are expected to <b>complete</b> all assignments/assessments and submit <b>original work</b> that is authentic and is reliable evidence that reflects students' knowledge and skill.</li> <li><b>Academic integrity</b> should be applied at all times, for all courses, by all students. Whether attending school face-to-face or through distance learning, Kamehameha Schools policy prohibits: cheating, plagiarism, copying, etc..</li> <li>All behavior and interaction online should be that of <b>respect, rapport and etiquette</b> to self, peers, and kumu.</li> </ul> |
| <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Canvas and<br/>Seesaw Course<br/>Responsibilities</b></p>         | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Follow the <b>2020-21 Kula Ha'aha'a Distance Learning Schedule</b> to know which classes to Zoom with or receive lessons from on Canvas/Seesaw for each day of the week.</li> <li>Please have all of course materials with you as needed.</li> <li>Kumu will be giving you feedback on assignments turned in. This should be addressed within 24 hours via email, Canvas or Seesaw.</li> <li>Submit all assignments by the due dates listed in the Canvas Calendar</li> </ul>  |
| <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Attendance</b></p>    | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Attendance for live Zoom sessions (synchronous) will be taken.</li> <li>Recorded sessions will be made available on Canvas for those who may miss the live Zoom session.</li> <li>Be sure to contact your child's kumu to let them know your child missed class but watched the recorded Zoom session so they can be marked "present".</li> </ul>  |
| <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Online<br/>Meeting<br/>Guidelines<br/>(Live or Recorded)</b></p>  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>KS uniform and appearance guidelines apply while on camera.</li> <li>Sit in an upright position at a table or appropriate study location (not on bed).</li> <li>Test your computer before class starts to make sure you can be seen and heard.</li> <li>Backgrounds, whether actual or virtual should be simple and not distracting.</li> <li>Be aware of background noise that may interfere with the audio such as fish tanks, TVs, radio, individuals talking or children playing.</li> <li>Log-in a few minutes before your scheduled synchronous session in order to be on time.</li> <li>Have your camera on and your microphone muted as you start an online session.</li> <li>Do not leave the class early (unless kumu has previously approved this early release).</li> <li>Live sessions and chat will be recorded.</li> </ul>  |

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| <p><b>Other Considerations</b></p>  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If you contact your teachers after 3:30pm they will respond within 24 hours. In other words, if you email them at 5 pm, they may not respond until the next morning.</li> <li>• Keep the lines of communication open with your kumu. Email them should you have any questions or if you need more support to be successful during distance learning.</li> <li>• Stick to a routine.</li> <li>• Designate a study area in your home that allows you to focus on your learning.</li> <li>• Make sure to take breaks throughout the day; step away from your iPad to allow time for you to go outside, exercise, grab a snack, do a hobby, etc.</li> </ul> |

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| <p>Synchronous<br/>(at the same time)</p> | <p>Virtual meeting with kumu and peers through Teams or Zoom that might include direct instruction, explicit delivery of content and introduction of skills, whole/small group discussion, live presentations, etc.</p> <p><i>Attendance will be taken for synchronous sessions</i></p>                |
| <p>Asynchronous<br/>(on your own)</p>     | <p>Access materials and resources that were posted in Canvas/Seesaw that offer direct instruction, explicit delivery of content and introduction or practice of skills.</p> <p>Complete posted assignments, tasks, or assessments such as discussion board, responses, research, view videos, etc.</p> |
